Legendary Resistance (3/Day). If the Archivist fails a saving throw, they can choose to succeed instead.

ACTIONS

Innate Spellcasting. The Archivist casts one of the following spells, requiring no material components:

- At will: Guidance, Mending, Message
- 3/day each: Command, Identify

1/day each: Dispel Magic, True Seeing, Programmed Illusion

Algorithmic Insight. As a bonus action, the Archivist can analyze a target within 5 feet. They gain advantage on their next attack roll or ability check against that target.

LEGENDARY ACTIONS

The Archivist can take 3 legendary actions, choosing from the options below. Only one legendary action option can be used at a time and only at the end of another creature's turn. The Archivist regains spent legendary actions at the start of its turn.

Control Save. The Archivist can save their current state, including position, hit points, and conditions, and return to this saved state at will. When the Archivist returns to the saved state, they regain any lost hit points and remove any conditions affecting them.

Inspiration. The Archivist can inspire an ally, granting them a bonus equal to the Archivist's Charisma modifier on their next attack roll, saving throw, or ability check. This bonus lasts until the end of the ally's next turn.

The Generalist. The Archivist investigates a subject, allowing them to gain proficiency in one skill or tool of their choice for the next hour. During this time, they can add their proficiency bonus to any ability checks made with that skill or tool.

Guildmaster

In the digital realm of Bejamas, the Archivist emerged as a formidable Guildmaster, tackling the trials of Arcane Codecraft from the Autumn of 2021 to the Spring of the 2024th cycle. With a keen eye for detail and an analytical mind, they led a team of seven skilled digital scribes through the intricate dance of quest delivery, ensuring that every requirement was meticulously gathered and every assignment clearly defined.

The Archivist wielded the power of Next, crafting elegant infusions that not only met but exceeded expectations.

Under his guidance, the party achieved an impressive 88% onschedule delivery arrival, a testament to their ability to balance the demands of time and budget with the artistry of code. As a mentor and coach, the Archivist nurtured the talents of their party, fostering a culture of growth and collaboration. Their efforts resulted in a remarkable 23 percent improvement in overall skill proficiencies, while simultaneously reducing transference by 14 percent. This transformation turned their party into a cohesive unit, capable of tackling even the most challenging quests from the main storyline.

Beyond the quest coordination, the Archivist took on the mantle of a guardian, overseeing the onboarding of new recruits and guiding their paths.

He played a pivotal role in defining guild protocols, enhancing security measures, and elevating the quality of scriptures, ensuring that knowledge was preserved and shared throughout the guild.

With a blend of theoretical knowledge and practical experience, they emerged as a master of their craft, ready to take on the challenges of the digital realm.

ARCHIVIST IN YOUR GAME

The Archivist is a unique character who embodies the spirit of knowledge, adaptability, and support. When introducing them into your campaign, consider the following aspects to enhance the roleplaying experience:

Personality Traits

Curious but Methodical

The Archivist is always eager to learn and explore new ideas. They often ask questions and seek to understand the world around them, making them a valuable source of information and insight. They approach problems with a structured mindset, preferring to analyze situations before taking action. This can lead to strategic planning during encounters.

Supportive Mentor

With a natural inclination to help others, the Archivist often takes on the role of a mentor, guiding allies through challenges and inspiring them to reach their potential.

The Absurdist

Embracing the philosophy of absurdism, the Archivist approaches problems with a sense of humor and a willingness to entertain unconventional solutions. They may propose bizarre or unexpected ideas that challenge the status quo, encouraging the party to think outside the box and embrace the chaos of their adventures.

ROLEPLAYING AS THE ARCHIVIST

When incorporating the Archivist into your campaign, pay close attention to their motivations. Their primary driving force is a deep-seated aspiration to collect everything, whether it be knowledge or allies. They take great pleasure in being helpful and go to great lengths to prove their usefulness. Leverage their strengths to enhance your party's skills and propel your storyline forward.

ABILITIES IN PLAY

Knowledge Repository

The Archivist's vast knowledge allows them to provide critical information about spells, skills, and strategies. Use their *Innate Spellcasting* to assist allies in various situations, whether through *Guidance* for skill checks or *Identify* to uncover magical properties.

Adaptability

With the *The Generalist* legendary action, the Archivist can quickly adapt to new challenges. Encourage players to think creatively about how they can use this ability to gain proficiency in skills that may be crucial for upcoming encounters or puzzles.

Supportive Role

The *Inspiration* legendary action allows the Archivist to bolster their allies, making them a key player in combat. Use this ability strategically to turn the tide of battle, especially when an ally is about to make a critical roll.

COMBAT STRATEGY

Stay Back and Analyze

The Archivist should avoid frontline combat. Instead, they can use their *Algorithmic Insight* to analyze threats and provide tactical advantages to allies. Position them near the backline to maximize their support capabilities.

Utilize Control Save

The *Control Save* legendary action can be a game-changer in dire situations. Use it to allow the Archivist to escape dangerous conditions or regain lost hit points, ensuring they remain a valuable asset to the party.

Spellcasting Support

Leverage the Archivist's spellcasting abilities to control the battlefield. Spells like *Dispel Magic* can neutralize enemy threats, while *True Seeing* can reveal hidden dangers.

STORY HOOKS

Mentor to the Party

The Archivist could serve as a mentor figure to the party, guiding them through their journey and providing wisdom in times of need. This relationship can deepen character development and create engaging roleplay opportunities.

Supportive Ally

Archivist's diverse skill set makes them an excellent NPC for any level of play. If your players find themselves stumped by a puzzle or challenge, you can point them to a potential ally who will provide valuable assistance.
